

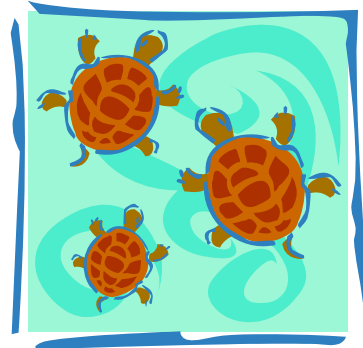

Mt. Kearsarge Indian Museum's (MKIM's) Turtle Island Camp offers children a chance to experience Native American culture through:

- ◇ activities and games
- ◇ adventure and exploration
- ◇ storytelling, music and art

Each week-long session will include visits from special guests and/or Native American tradition bearers.

#### STAFF

Staff is composed of **trained instructors** who have experience with children and are **certified in First Aid.**

A **program barn** provides shelter and the **museum galleries** offer educational opportunities. Outdoor exploration takes place on **10 acres of fields and forest**, including the tranquil **Medicine Woods Nature Trail.** Turtle Island is **licensed by the State of New Hampshire.**

## SESSION TOPICS AND DATES



### Session 1: June 28 - July 1 Land, Lore, and Animals

Habitats determine which animals can live where, and the environment also has an impact on people. Hike to a beaver pond, trek through the trees, or dream about the desert to discover the ways that the land has shaped the culture and traditions of tribes across the country.

### Session 2: July 6 - 9 The Powwow is Coming!

*(no camp 7/5: reduced rate \$148/M, \$172/NYM)*

Intertribal Powwows are a celebration of Native American culture. Make a drum, learn a dance, enjoy flute music. Share a behind the scenes look at many aspects of Native traditions that will be presented at MKIM's annual Powwow on July 10-11. Campers receive a free pass to the Powwow!

### Session 3: July 12-16 Games and Challenges

Games can be more than fun. They can teach important life skills such as observation, agility, and cooperation. Make traditional Native American games, then test your brain and body, or work as a team with others. Make and take toys that can extend your fun long after the week is over.

### Session 4: July 19-23 I Made It Myself!

Birch bark canoes, wampum beads and leather bags are all created out of materials from nature. Create your own "artifacts" as you explore the skills and collect the materials used to produce the tools and artwork of Native Americans today and throughout history.

### Session 5: July 26 - July 30 Archaeology Week

Ancient pictures painted on cave walls, pieces of broken pottery, spear points found in local fields, are all clues from the past. They are puzzle pieces waiting to be formed into a story. Investigate what it's like to put those pieces together and discover stories from the people who came before us.

### Session 6: August 2 - 6 Living Off the Land

Searching for wild foods, harvesting the garden, and preserving food for winter are important skills for Native Americans and anyone who has lived close to the land. Gather fruits of the season and discover just how many of the foods we eat today were introduced by the first people of New Hampshire.
